Tammy's Tidbits

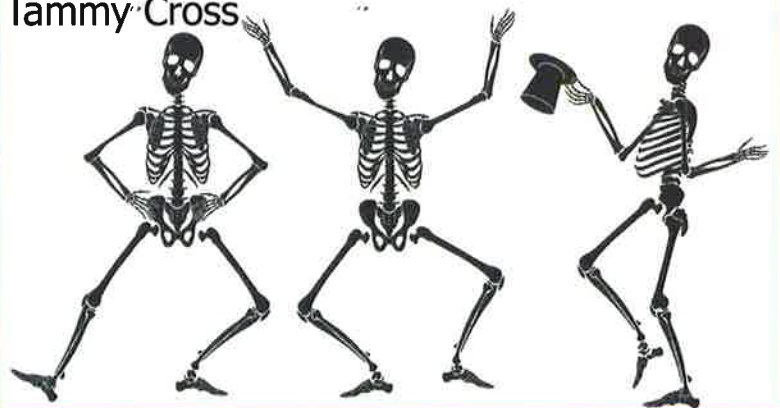
My philosophy is to introduce children to as much as possible in their early years, so they may learn the developmental skills and academics needed to be successful in their elementary years.

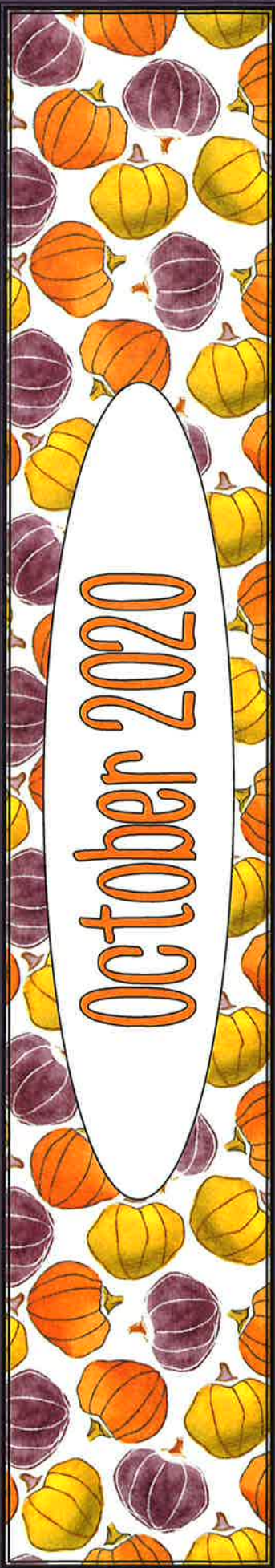
